FT-1 Korean Folk Village & Hwaseong Fortress (09:00-18:00 Apr.8)



Price : KRW85,000/person (Minimum 10persons basis)

Itinerary : Tour Desk – Korean Folk Village - Lunch – Suwon Hwaseong Fortress – Tour Desk

Conditions : Admission, Lunch, English-speaking guide, Fully air-conditioned motor coach

Description : **Korean Folk Village** is a living museum that recreates the lifestyle of several centuries ago. There are potters, weavers, blacksmiths, and other artisans who practice their trades in traditional fashion. There are also 240 traditional homes and a small amphitheater for music and folk dances. **Suwon Hwaseong Fortress**, the Brilliant Fortress in Suwon, Gyeonggi-do Province, was built with the first use of cranes and other latest construction engineering of the 18th century. The construction was planned by the 22nd king of the Joseon Dynasty, Jeongjo, when he moved his father's tomb in 1789. Each structure well harmonizes architectural splendor and function on a key strategic spot.

FT-2 Unique Experience “Panmunjeon” Tour (07:30-18:30, Apr.8)

Itinerary : Tour Desk – Lotte hotel – Imjingak Park – Camp Bonifas(Briefing) – Lunch – Panmunjeom/JSA – Lotte hotel – Tour Desk

Conditions : Admission, Lunch, English-speaking guide, Fully air-conditioned motor coach (only Transfers)

Description : Truly a unique & rare experience in the whole world. This visit will leave you with a dramatic sense of the tremendous tragedy of separated families, the division of the peninsula and the hopes for reunification. The North Korean 3rd Tunnel is one of several underground tunnels dug under the DMZ (demilitarized zone) by North Korea for the purpose of infiltrating troops into South Korea in case of hostilities. It is deep under the surface and tourists are invited to descend to the bottom to view it for themselves. Cameras are permitted in the DMZ but it is essential that all visitors bring along their passports.

Notice :

- Must bring your passport on tour day.
- No tour on every Sunday & national holiday.
- Only English Speaking Guide who have permission from US army goes into Panmujeom area and you should join the tour because just a few travel agencies can handle it.
(The tour departure time is different every day.)
- Dress code : No Jeans, Sandals, Shorts, Short Pants, Short Skirts, Sleeveless Shirts, T-Shirts, Shirts Without collars or Sports Ware.
- Tour route and schedule are subject to change without notice whenever there is an official request from the UNC.

FT-4 Seoul City Tour (09:00-17:00, Apr.8)

Itinerary : Tour Desk – Blue House pass by - Cheonggye Stream – Gyeongbok Palace & National Folk Museum – Insadong Antique Street - Lunch – Namsangol Hanok Village – N-Seoul Tower Observatory – Namdaemun Market - Tour Desk

Conditions : Admission, Lunch, English-speaking guide, Fully air-conditioned motor coach

Description : **Blue house** is the president residence of the Republic of Korea. **Gyeongbok Palace** built in 1394 as a primary residence for the royal family, **National Folk Museum** which explains the religious rituals, housing customs, household tools, housing implements, food, and social dynamics of traditional Korean life. **Namsangol Hanok Village** beautiful village is composed of three parts : a traditional Korean Garden, Time Capsule Plaza and the village itself, which includes Hanok from the Joseon Dynasty. These houses were moved from their original locations around Seoul and completely restored. **N Seoul Tower**, located on the top of Mt. Namsan, where visitors can take in a panoramic view of the city. **Namdaemun Market** traditional market : is the nation's wholesale center and virtually anything you want can be found here : clothing, shoes, house wares, foodstuffs, flowers, tools, wigs, glasses. Accessories of every kind, gift items, sporting etc.

Description : **N-Seoul Tower** is equipped with observatories and a revolving restaurant for a full 360° view. There are also the Global Village Folk Museum, which maintains over 20,000 rare and precious relics from over 150 countries and a 3-D theater, etc.
